KENNETH ANDERSON

Kenneth Anderson grew up in Sturgeon Bay. He was baptized and confirmed at Bay View Lutheran church and graduated from Sturgeon Bay High school. As a young adult, he moved to San Francisco and worked in the airline industry for many years. Although he lived on the west coast, he always returned to Sturgeon Bay and his family for holidays. His nephew remembers him as a kindly man who lived in a small apartment with a beautiful view of San Francisco Bay and who drove an old Toyota but collected art. Mr. Anderson died in 1997 and left a bequest to Bay View Lutheran Church, specifying that the money be used for **educational** purposes.

THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Endowment Funds Committee (EFC) of Bay View Lutheran Church which administers this fund awards scholarships to students within the community who possess excellent academic skills and potential, admirable personal character, Christian faith, a commitment to service to others and financial need.

The EFC will consider applications from students of all ages and for a variety of educational programs. The governing document specifies scholarships be granted for Christian vocations, human service vocations and for other deserving vocations. Recipients of scholarships may reapply annually. Applications are reviewed twice a year at our Dec. 15 and April 15 deadlines. Determination of awards is normally within 30 days of the application deadline. Applications are available by email from the Bay View Lutheran Church office, bayview@bvlc.org or 920-743-4705. Scholarship awards will be paid to the school indicated in the application and may be paid in increments as permitted by the school. The recipient must periodically keep the EFC informed of changes in school attendance or academic standing from those listed on the application. The recipient must submit semester or quarter grades to the EFC. The EFC reserves the right to adjust or withdraw the scholarship if the recipient's educational program changes from that indicated on the application. All information contained in the application or related recommendations will remain confidential. Applicants and recipients must keep the EFC informed of any other scholarships, awards or funding received.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Obtain and complete application form

Obtain and submit a transcript for (at least) your four most recent school years.

Obtain and submit four letters of recommendation.

These letters of recommendation should be submitted on the form provided with your application. If possible, one of the recommendations should be from a member of Bay View Lutheran Church. One or two of the recommendations should be from a teacher, principal or counselor who knows you as a student. One or two recommendations must be from a community member who knows your performance as an employee or volunteer. One letter of recommendation may be from a friend other than a family member. These criteria may be combined: that is a recommendation may be written by an individual who knows you as a student and is a member of Bay View Lutheran Church.
